IMPORTANT GUIDELINES FOR THE ONLINE ATKT EXAMS NOV/DEC 2020 AS PER THE CIRCULAR OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MUMBAI DATED 3RD NOVEMBER 2020 FOLLOWING ARE THE EXAMINATION GUIDELINES FOR THE BACKLOG/ EXSTUDENTS OF ALL THE SEMESTERS (STUDENTS WHO WERE ELIGIBLE TO APPEAR FOR THE MARCH/ APRIL 2020 ATKT EXAMINATION I.E. SEMESTERS I TO IV OF 3 YEARS COURSE AND SEMESTERS I TO VIII OF 5 YEARS COURSE):

Guidelines for the Online ATKT exams November 2020-December 2020.

- 1. Examinations of Semesters I to IV of the Gen. LL. B. (3 years) course and of Semesters I to VIII of the B.L.S. / LL. B. (5 years) course shall be conducted for the students of the Academic Year 2019-20 and also for the students of earlier batches (backlog/ exstudents) who were eligible to appear for the March/ April/May 2020 ATKT Examination for these Semesters.
- 2. These exams shall be conducted from 25th November to 12th December 2020.
- 3. The Timetable for these ATKT exams shall be shared in due course.
- 4. The exam shall be of the entire syllabus as prescribed by the University of Mumbai.
- 5. Only students who have duly filled the examination forms are eligible to appear for this ATKT examination.
- 6. The colleges shall allot Seat Numbers to all such students.
- 7. The exams shall be held **online mode**. Details of the mode shall be shared in due course.
- 8. Students must make requisite arrangements to appear for the online examination. (i.e. Smartphone/ Laptop/ Desktop/ any other gadget/ Internet Connectivity)
- 9. Students must ensure that they make themselves aware of the syllabus, paper pattern, timetable and the technical platform used by the college.
- 10. Two MOCK TESTS (PRACTICE EXAMS) of 10 SAMPLE MCQs each shall be conducted before the MAIN EXAM.
- 11. In case of any difficulties in the MOCK TESTS (PRACTICE EXAMS) or any other queries related therein, students can contact the college authorities on the following numbers:

- 12. The MAIN EXAM shall be in the form of 25 Compulsory Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) for each subject for 2 marks each and total marks of each subject shall be 50 marks. These marks shall be converted into 100/60 marks as applicable to the respective batches. The duration of each exam shall be 1 hour.
- 13. In case any student is unable to attempt the online ACTUAL EXAM due to network issues, he/she should inform the college via email within 2 hours from the time of the exam.
- 14. Students shall not resort to the use of unfair means while attempting the online examination. Strict action shall be initiated against such students for use of unfair means as per the University Rules & Regulations.
- 15. The results shall be declared by the colleges as directed by the University of Mumbai.

16. Since this is an online MCQ examination, there shall be 'NO REVALUATION' of assessments.
