Word Limit: 2500 – 4000 words (excluding footnotes).

Citation Style: ILI Citation Style.

Font Style: Title: 16 pt, Bold, Headings: 14 pt, Bold

Text: Times New Roman, 12 pt, Footnotes: Times New Roman, 10 pt

Line Spacing: 1.5, Alignment: Justified

Plagiarism shall not exceed 10%.

AI generated content shall not exceed 20%

Selected papers may be published in an edited book journal with ISBN subject to review and editorial policies. Publication charges shall be additional and shall be informed to the authors.
