POLICY ON PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES (PwDs)

M.K.E.S. College Of Law since its inception believes in holistic development of its students including those with disabilities. The College strongly believes in creating a inclusive teaching and learning environment with unbiased treatment for disabled students. All the activities are accessible by disabled students. All the authorities and teaching faculties of the institute are endeavoring to extend a helping hand towards the differently abled students to make sure about the overall growth of disabled students through education.

As per the Person with Disability Act, disability is of different types —

- 1) Physical Disability
 - a. Locomotor Disability
 - b. Visual Impairment
 - c. Hearing Impairment
 - d. Speech and Language Disability
- 2) Intellectual Disability
 - a. Specific Learning Disabilities
 - b. Autism Spectrum Disorder
- 3) Mental Behaviour (Mental Illness)
- 4) Disability caused due to
 - a. Chronic Neurological Conditions such as-

b. Blood Disorder

5) Multiple Disabilities

M.K.E.S. College of Law recognizes that Persons with Disabilities are a valuable human resource for the country and seeks to create an environment that provides those equal opportunities, protection of their rights and full participation in society.



Objectives of the Policy:

- 1. To create inclusive environment of equality avoiding discrimination towards disabled students from all domains of work and education.
- 2. To create appropriate regulatory mechanism to treat disabled students without any partiality in an effective manner.
- 3. To ensure attainment of vision and mission of legislative measures with respect to persons with disabilities.
- 4. To ensure right to education for disabled students.
- To ensure equal opportunities of development and overall growth of disabled students.
- 6. To arrange finance for facilitating above objectives and enhancing infrastructure to make college campus disabled friendly.

Eligibility for admission of person with disability

Any disabled student becomes eligible to get admission in the college if he/she is qualified to participate in any given institute program or activity.

Accessibility policy

Providing access means making all the college services, activities and the benefits thereof, fully available to qualified people with disabilities. The institute strive to provide various provisions in creating a disabled friendly campus. The administration, teaching and non-teaching staff of the institute is directed to ensure appropriate/reasonable accommodations for each person with a disability, and be willing to resolve access problems. The campus is designed to be barrier free and accessible for differently abled person.



The following principles of accessibility will be strictly observed:

- All UG and PG programs and activities must be accessible.
- To provide accessible study material to prepare and appear for examination for all students with disabilities.
- The institute will ensure the representation of all the types of disabilities listed in Rights of Persons with Disabilities 2016 and as per government regulations from time to time.

Exam policy

Examination department of M.K.E.S. College of Law is also aware and concerned about educational need of disabled students. Committee is directed to consider need of such students for examination, making it convenient and comfortable for them.

Accessibility to college campus for persons with disabilities

Facilities available for students are:

- 1. Ramps to access to lift in all wings of the college.
- **2.** Classroom allotment on ground floor on preferential basis during examinations.
- 3. Disabled friendly toilet.
- **4.** Other facilities are provided time to time as per government rules.
- **5.** Students are sensitised on their duty as a classmate towards disabled students during orientation.
- 6. The institution has disabled friendly, barrier free environment.
